Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 3:02 by chair, P.J. Lopez.

The minutes of the December 3, 2024 meeting were approved.

APSA Subcommittee: Subcommittee member, Greg Larson, reported on the work of the subcommittee. Greg reported that the subcommittee was continuing its work including materials defining an “enterprise” and a “medical service provider” within the meaning of APSA.

Guardianship Instructions: P.J. reported that the Guardianship Task Force had circulated the draft guardianship instructions and had received comments from members of the bar.

Premises Liability Subcommittee: Subcommittee Chair, Steve Kramer, reported that the subcommittee was still waiting for the Supreme Court’s decision in the *Perez* case and that the subcommittee would continue its work after the court rules in *Perez*.

Wrongful Death Damages Subcommittee: Subcommittee Chair, Richard Langerman, led a discussion of the proposed comment to the wrongful death damages instruction. While no votes were taken, there was a consensus of approval for the proposed comment.

Other Business: Richard Langerman reported that he had been alerted that the print edition of RAJI (Civil) 7th Personal Injury Damages No. 1 does not include the revisions adopted by the Committee in 2017. Ilona indicated that she would see to it that future print editions of the RAJI's would be corrected. Ilona confirmed that the language of the instruction on the State Bar website has the wording approved by the Committee in 2017.
