The State Bar of Arizona's lobbying efforts are restricted by both the US Supreme Court decision, *Keller v. State Bar of California*, and Arizona Supreme Court rule. It may only take positions on issues related to "... regulating the legal profession and improving the quality of legal services ..."

During 2019, the State Bar of Arizona did not actively lobby the state Legislature on any Bar-sponsored bills, nor were there any bills that the Bar actively lobbied against.

### 2019 ABA Day in Washington DC

The State Bar of Arizona participated in ABA Day in Washington DC on April 9-11, 2019. Members of the State Bar delegation met with Arizona's Congressional delegation to discuss increased funding for the Legal Services Corporation to improve access to legal services in our state.
